Key information for groups

- **The McManus opens to the public at 10am**; access is not available before this time.
- **Bus pick up and drop off is at the north side of the building** (Queen Victoria statue). Minibus parking is also available in this area. Minibus spaces cannot be reserved but on arrival drivers can collect a parking permit to display for the duration of the visit.
- **Eating and drinking is not permitted in any public areas of the museum** and for conservation reasons museum staff must approach any visitor holding bottles / foodstuffs and ask that they are put away. A snack break can be requested as part of a group visit.
- **The museum does not have a packed lunch area for groups** however groups are encouraged to make use of outside bench seating and garden areas.
- The use of cameras and video equipment **without flash** is permitted in most gallery areas – staff can advise on any restrictions.
