Selling Dreams: One Hundred Years of Fashion Photography is the second in a series of exhibitions being held at The McManus: Dundee's Art Gallery and Museum leading up to the opening of the V&A at Dundee.

The exhibition features works by giants of twentieth century photography including Edward Steichen, Irving Penn, Richard Avedon, Helmut Newton and David Bailey, alongside contemporary images by Corinne Day, Rankin, Tim Walker and Steven Meisel.

The V&A is home to the UK's National Collection of the Art of Photography. Selling Dreams is drawn from this collection and is the first V&A touring exhibition to explore the work of international fashion photographers from the earliest years of the twentieth century to the present day.
